- Clifford attended a Meeting of Presidents held by the Faculty of Health Student Caucus to discuss events and possible collaborations for the upcoming academic year

 2012 in the Calumet Courtyard
 - Bethune College was asked if they would be interested in supporting the event
 - Some council members express reservations about supporting the event

 - Vote: 0 for, 5 against, 2 abstain
 - Motion Does Not Pass
- Faculty of Health Caucus proposed a levee for the Health Student Caucus whereby they would charge students 30 cents per credit
 - Health Caucus is seeking Bethune College Council's support (need 10% of students to vote in favour of the proposed levee for it to proceed)
 - General concensus is that council seems to support informing the students of the levee and encouraging them to vote

 - Seconded by Kian
 - Vote: 8 for, 0 against, 0 abstain
 - Motion Passed

4. Orientation Chair's Report

- Discussed Alcohol EDU, an online education awareness mandatory for all frosh leaders
