2. Naim's Update

Duties of a General Member:

- Must be a member of a Social Committee; however, each general member will also be assigned to a specific BCC committee.
- Plan and implement at least one major and one minor event which may be social, academic or educational in nature.
- The event budget must be due 5 weeks prior to the event; the event promotion should begin 4 weeks prior to the event and the tickets should be sold 3 weeks prior to the event.
- Must keep a record of progress that should be presented to the Social Committee and reported to the Vice-President Social.
- The event budget should be proposed at the Social Committee meetings, voted on and approved by the Vice-President Finance; the approved event budget and the event itself should be proposed at the general council meeting and discussed with the Vice-President External and Master's Office regarding event promotions and ticket sales.
- TUS form must be signed as soon as possible in order to hold an event at Bethune College.
- An assistant will be assigned to each general member to assist with a major event planning.

3. Frosh Revival Update

- The scheduled date is Friday, September 13th, 2013.
- Mudd Magazine will be sponsoring/hosting the event and inviting fashion industry models, artists and agencies.

4. SOS Representative Update

- Discussed a possibility of making a video to promote SOS services and peer advising.
