2. New College Finance

- BCC placed an order on buses two years ago for Frosh Week 2011, which was later on, cancelled. As an outcome, BCC owes New College \$1000. The cheque issued by BCC has been misplaced and requested to be issued again by New College's Council.
- The motion for council's approval was not raised due to the absence of New College's VP Finance; the details will be further discussed by the Finance Committee.

4. Promotions and Marketing Plan

- Vice-President External, Victoria Sparrow-Downes, has resigned from Bethune College Council.
 - The last Promotion and Marketing Committee meeting was an emergency meeting held on June 25, 2013. All future meetings will be announced in advance.
 - The duties of Vice-President External are divided between the two Digital Media Assistants, College Mascot and Director of Clubs and Affiliates and the VP External re-election will be held when the first year representatives are elected.
 - The remainder of VP External's honorarium from the beginning of the term until October's Elections should be split between the four members of Promotions and Marketing Committee. *The details will be discussed at the next Finance Committee meeting and then finalized with BCC.
- A pamphlet will be sent out to all incoming first year Bethune College students. The
 first side will include information about clubs, athletics and SOS. Frosh week and
 year-round event schedules will be printed out separately on the remaining sides of
 the pamphlet.
- The BCC website is in process of updating; all the members that would like to contribute must address their ideas/opinions to the President or Digital Media Assistants.
 - Suggested 20 second introduction videos for BCC members instead of 150 word personal blurbs.
 - The BCC website will also feature an introduction video for each club affiliated with Bethune College.
 - o Council Portraits will be taken at the next general meeting, July 16, 2013.
- The list of all clubs affiliated with Bethune College has been updated and can be found at bethune.yorku.ca/clubs.
 - o A Facebook group will be created for all Bethune Clubs' Executives.

- The first Bethune wide Club meeting will be held in mid July, 2013 and before Frosh Week to help out with York Fest.
- The Frosh Kit will also include a Bethune Pen/Highlighter with Bethune College web address printed on and be given out to students at YorkFest.
 - o Any unused remaining Frosh goods will be given out to students at YorkFest.
 - A photo booth will be set up with Bethune Dragon and the taken pictures will be posted on Facebook.
- Every future event must follow a specific promotional strategy:
 - o Promotional Video two or three minutes in duration.
 - Physical paper poster
 - Updated Digital Signage
 - Facebook, Twitter and YU Connect updates.
 - Ensuring that the clubs are aware of details and updates.
- Bethune clothing line will be available for sale on the first day of Frosh Week including T-shirts, pullover and zip up hoodies, dri-FIT T-shirts and socks with Bethune Dragon "built-in" embroidery.
 - The cost of Council's Frosh Week Jerseys will be \$30. The payment is due to Vice-President Finance and the remaining balance will be subsidized.
- One computer from the Executive office will be moved into BCC general office and will be reserved strictly for Digital Media Assistants.

5. Finance Report

- The next Finance Committee meeting will be concerning about the distribution of VP External's honorarium and VP Social's <u>approved</u> event budget. The date of the meeting will be scheduled soon.

6. VP Athletics Report
